Description

Enduro Gradec is a mountain bike enduro race, hosting the Austrian national championships, the third round of the Central European Enduro series and has the status of an Enduro World Series Qualifier event. The event center will be located in Stattegg near Graz. All courses will start from here onto Schöckl mountain and return back here. Training and prologue will take place on Saturday. On Sunday six special stages will be on the program. Riders with and without a national license starting from the age of 16 are eligible to participate.

Course

Start and finish is in Stattegg near Graz. A short prologue (about one minute) will be held close to the start/finish area. On Sunday the course winds its way up to the top of Schöckl mountain. Appr. 1.000 meters of climbing will be done the riders themselves. The Schöckl gondola takes care of the rest. Between stages 2 and 4 will be a feed/technical zone. The majority of stages is on natural singletrails with roots and rocks.

Gondola

A special ticket for training will be on sale at the bottom station of the gondola, which costs \in 15,and is valid on Friday and Saturday. The gondola ticket for the race on Sunday is included within the starting fee.

Accomodation & Amenities

Parking spots for camper vans are located directly at the event area Lässerhof (Hofweg 2, 8046 Graz, Austria). Showers are close by at the local sports field. Bike washing places will be signed.

Rulels

- The race will be held according to the rules of the ÖRV (www.radsportverband.at/images/Verband/Reglement/4-mtb 2017-02-26.pdf) and the UCI.
- Participants below the age of 18 need to present a signed letter of consent of a legal guardian.
- The race will be held on marked trails with natural and man-made obstacles.
- The following gear is mandatory on stages:
 - Fullface helmet (a halfshell helmet is sufficient on transfers)
 - Back protection/protection backpack
 - Gloves
 - Knee protection
 - Protection gear will checked at the start. Missing protection gear results in disqualification.
- The bike needs to be in a flawless state and is not permitted to posses any engine (i.e. electro motor).
- The bike needs to be fitted with the official race number on the handle bars.
- Frame, wheels and fork will be marked and are not allowed to be switched during race start and race end.
- Starting order of the stages will be in order of race numbers.
- The start interval on stages is 30 seconds.
- Timing chips and start numbers need to be returned immediately after the race. In case of loss a fee of € 50,- will be charged.
- Winners are the persons with the lowest overall time on all timed stages (including prologue) in their categories.
- The winner of each category will be awarded a trophy.
- Results will be published on <u>www.enduro-gradec.at</u> after the race.
- All participants take part on their own risk and cost.
- The organizer does not take any liability for damages between riders and or third parties.
- In case of bad weather or other unforseeable events, the organizer reserves the right to alter the course.
